DETAILS AND CRITERIA FOR 19TH THAILAND NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

- Date : 21st to 27th April 2012
Participants are advised to arrive on 21st April 2012 and leave the Jamboree site by 27th November 2012.
- Venue : Vajiravudh National Scout Camp
Chonburi Province, Sriracha, East of Thailand
- Theme : Centennial of Thai Scouting
- Fee : \$1000. The fees will cover Jamboree Kits, Meals, Tents, On-site activities, off-site educational visit to places of interest; travel insurance; Airfares; inland transportation between the airport and the Jamboree Site.
- Eligibility : Scouts aged 13 – 17 are welcome to join the Jamboree as participants.
Leaders and Rovers aged 18 and above may sign up as contingent staff or as members of the International Service Team (IST)
- Equipment : Participants should bring their personal belongings including sleeping bag, flashlight, Scout Uniform, sportswear and raingear; etc
- Climate : Thailand has a tropical, humid climate with temperatures averaging 35°C
- Highlights : Exciting adventure challenges which include Water Activities; Survival Skill; Art & Crafts; Global Development Village; Badge Trading and Environment Conservation
